18. Screen Doors

Design Committee approval is required for all screen and security screen doors except those that have clean lines and are simple in design.

- A. Any designs which incorporate scroll work, pictures of any kind, spires, sunbursts, filigree or decorative elements will require Design Committee approval.
- B. The Dimensions of the security screen door shall cover the threshold of the doorframe.
- C. The colors of the exterior surfaces visible from the street or neighboring properties shall complement the existing, approved trim color or be black or white.
- D. Reflective finishes may not be used on exterior surfaces, other than the surfaces of the hardware fixtures.
- E. Screen doors shall be maintained in a good and clean condition and repair.
